If seeking licensure or certification, applicants to the program are responsible for contacting their state department of education for licensure requirements and program approval. In addition, fingerprint and background clearance is required.

<sup>1</sup> Includes all traditional students who have a last date of attendance at least three weeks into the Fall 2023 semester, students who participated in a campus evening class in September or October of 2023 and students who have participated in an online class in August or September 2023.

<sup>2</sup> Excluding observational and practice-based experiences and student teaching.

<sup>3</sup> MOU 9120 & MOU 9121: This scholarship is only valid for those applicants who are participating in a GCU College of Education or Secondary Education Emphasis master's degree program, offered online, and who submit a completed application to start their program on or before December 31, 2024. If you enroll in a Master's degree program through any of the College of Education or Secondary Education Emphasis degree programs offered online, Grand Canyon University will offer you 18% off the tuition per course for your program. This scholarship will be applied at the same time the tuition charges occur. This scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other GCU scholarships/awards. This scholarship will be applied toward your tuition only and does not include fees (i.e., Canyon Connect, Technology, etc).

<sup>4</sup> GCU is offering a scholarship of up to 25% off tuition when 10 or more students join a cohort.

<sup>5</sup> MOU 6112: This scholarship is only valid for applicants who are employed as classified staff or paraprofessionals at a PLLS member district/school in a state other than Arizona or Texas, and submit a complete application. This scholarship will be applied toward your tuition only and cannot be used in conjunction with any other GCU scholarship or award.

<sup>6</sup> MOU 3060: This scholarship is only valid for applicants who are faculty, staff or governing board members\* of a "Participants in Learning, Leading and Serving" member district or school outside Arizona and Texas, and who submit a complete application.
