

Terrion Wright (Sophomore)- *"I am thankful for meeting new people & friends at Thornton."*





London Wash (Sophomore)- *"I am thankful for waking up healthy every morning."*




Abrielle Jones (Junior)- *"I am most thankful for my parents because they take care of me and support me."*
