Semester Completion & Early Finish Information

As the first semester comes to a close, it's important that all students are on track to complete and pass all of their courses.

Starting **December 1st**, the view in Imagine Learning/Edgenuity will change from showing your Overall and Actual grades to displaying your **Relative Grade**. The Relative Grade is what will appear on report cards at the end of the semester. It includes zeros for any work not yet completed—even assignments still scheduled for December. **Grades will drop temporarily**, but as students reach 100% completion, the Overall, Actual, and Relative Grades will all be the same.

For students who are ahead in their courses, we are excited to offer the opportunity for an extended Winter Break starting as early as December 1st. To qualify, students must:

- Complete 100% of all Imagine Learning/Edgenuity courses with a minimum passing grade of 60%, and
- Coordinate with teachers of in-person electives (Aviation, PE, Smart Lab, Friday electives, etc.) to finish finals and submit any required projects early.

Students who meet these requirements must obtain signatures from all teachers on the Semester Check-Out Sheet. Once approved, they will be marked as Finished Early for attendance purposes. Please note that Finished Early does not negatively impact attendance rates.
