Students will return to school on **Tuesday, January 6, 2026.**



Advanced Options Night: Grades 6-11



Location: Marysville High School Auditorium (Alumni Hall- Entrance E)

Who: All families interested in College Credit Plus, Internships and/or AP & Advanced Options information

Attention **6th Grade** Parents:

This night will provide valuable information about College Credit Plus (CCP), Internship Opportunities, and Advanced options in our school District. We will provide information and have representatives from OSU Marion, Columbus State, and Clark State. This meeting is designed for any family grades 6-11 who may be interested in future college classes. If you cannot attend, information will be sent out after this meeting.

There will be 3 different sessions occurring at the same time. Each family can attend the session they are interested in or attend all 3 sessions. The sessions will be from 6:00 - 6:30 pm, 6:35 - 7:05 pm and 7:10 - 7:40 pm. Each session will include the below information and will be repeated every 30 minutes to ensure all families can attend as many sessions as they would like to attend.

College Credit Plus (CCP) Informational Session: This session will discuss policy, and procedures for both MECHS and MHS. **Students who would like to participate in our College Credit Plus program MUST complete a counselor meeting by law before taking a College Credit Plus course.** This night will fulfill this requirement.

Internship and work based learning opportunities: This session will be about internship opportunities for rising 11-12 graders available at MHS and ECHS. Internships, or work-based learning opportunities, are intended for junior and senior students that are interested in gaining experience in future career fields of interest.

Advanced Placement (AP) Information: The third session of the night will be about Advanced Placement (AP) classes and other advanced options available at MHS only. (current MHS, and potential future MHS families are invited if they are interested).
