### Community

Naperville is a suburban community of nearly 150,000 residents. It is located thirty miles west of Chicago on I-88, the high-tech corridor running through the western suburbs. The majority of residents are engaged in business, professional, managerial, and technical occupations.

### School

Naperville North High School is a public, four-year comprehensive high school with over 230 certified staff members, a majority of whom have a Master's degree or beyond. The school day consists of eight periods, including one period for lunch. All classes meet five days per week, during two 18-week semesters.
