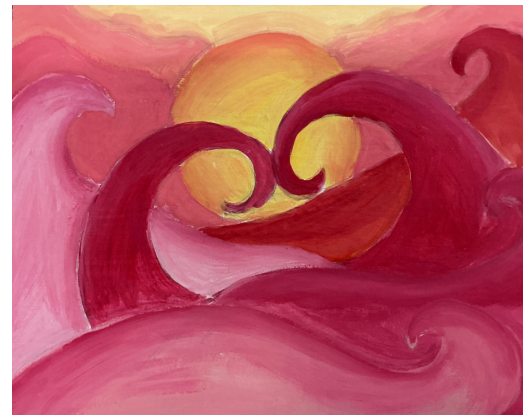

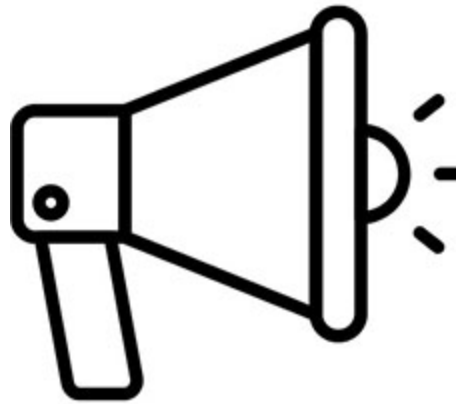
CV will host the SATs on the following dates:
