HOW IS THE ONE TEAM, ONE GOAL: OUR FAMILY-SCHOOL PLAN DEVELOPED AND REVISED?

Each spring, all families are invited to attend a meeting to review and revise our One Team,

One Goal: Our Family-School Plan. Additionally, all families are encouraged to complete a parent and family engagement survey, providing essential information. Feedback on activities and workshops that were provided throughout the school year. This includes how CVE's 1% set-aside budget should be spent in the coming school year. This survey remains on the school website all year, as parental and family input is welcome at any time. We use the feedback from this survey and other input to drive our decision-making. Residential facilities in our district are also included in the activities and correspondence for family engagement.

COMMUNICATION: Frequent two-way communication with families about student learning is highly encouraged. Annual Community Title 1 Meeting- We will discuss proposed goals for the 2026-2027 school year. This meeting is scheduled for May 19, 2026, at 3:00 pm

OUR DISTRICT GOALS

Reading: At the end of the 2026 school year, we will see a 3% increase in the percentage of students who are proficient and above on Georgia Milestone ELA assessments from the 2025 results.

Math: At the end of the 2026 school year, we will see a 3% increase in the percentage of students who are proficient and above on Georgia Milestone Math assessments from the 2025 results.

OUR SCHOOL GOALS

Goal #1: Chattanooga Valley Elementary will increase the percentage of students performing at the Proficient and Distinguished levels in the areas of ELA and Math on the Georgia EOG by 20% by 2030. We will particularly emphasize levels 3 and 4; however, we will continue to move all students and show improvement on the CCRPI indicator (“Percent of students scoring at Developing Level and above on the Georgia Milestones EOG”).

*ELA- from 38.7% Proficient (P) and Distinguished (D) in 2021 (71.77% were Developing, P, & D) to 58.7%% in 2030.

*Math- from 40.38% Proficient (P) and Distinguished (D) in 2021 (73.9% were D, P, & D) to 60.38% in 2030.

Goal #2: Chattanooga Valley Elementary will increase the percentage of students in grades 1-5 meeting student growth projections on the MAP Assessment in the areas of ELA and Math on the NWEA MAP Assessment from 61% in ELA (2025) and 70% in math (2025) by 10% by 2030.

Chattanooga Valley Elementary will provide all students with high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment to meet high academic

standards.

We will create and maintain a school culture/climate in which students feel a sense of belonging concerning all school-wide activities and processes.

We will implement and maintain instructional/social supports to maximize student achievement. We will increase the percentage of K-2 students performing on or above grade level on district assessments and the percentage of 3-5 students performing on or above grade level on the Georgia Milestones Assessment.

CVE teachers will target foundational early reading skills and comprehension tasks to develop strong readers. We will use Quality Plus Mathematical Practices and Rich Mathematical tasks to develop expertise in mathematical thinking. Students will work in small groups and collaboratively to solve real-world problems.

WHAT IS OUR ONE TEAM, ONE GOAL: OUR FAMILY-SCHOOL PLAN? It is a plan that describes how our school will provide opportunities to improve family engagement that will support student learning at school and at home. All students and their families are invited and encouraged to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. The school will provide information and as many opportunities as possible for the participation of all family members.

- Collaborate with community organizations and businesses to promote student success.
- Collect feedback from parents/families at all events and encourage feedback throughout the school year to improve the school-wide Title I plan.
- Inform families in residential facilities in the district that they are included in all our parent/family involvement activities and correspondences.
