### Student Voice Day – Key Take Aways

Feedback we received from Students...

- **Recognition & Rewards (KOR Kash / PBIS)**
  - Students want better prizes (Suggested tiered prize systems)
- **Clubs, Activities, and Events**
  - More cross-grade clubs/teams/activities
  - Monthly schoolwide events or themed days (similar to Pink Out)
- **Field Trips and Fundraising**
  - Students want more frequent field trips and a desire to offer input on trip choices.
- **Mentorship, Relationships, and School Climate**
  - Develop/continue to improve mentor programs between grades in preparation for realignment
- **Scheduling and School Structure**
  - Input on their class placement and feeling more valued in larger picture decision making
- **Other suggestions:** Nap-time, less homework, offer Italian as Foreign Language, better lunches
