Audition Information

The Drama Club is offered to students in 3rd-5th grade. Students in 4th and 5th grade may audition for a main role. Students in grades 3-5 may be part of the ensemble (no audition necessary). ONLY 5th grade students can apply to be a part of our stage crew. Spots are limited to 12 students and will be selected based on a completed application. All students interested in the Drama Club must sign up.

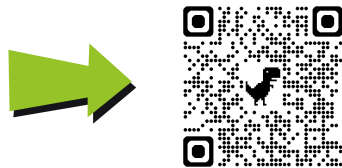
#1 Moana: “How Far I’ll Go” + Moana Script

#3 Maui: “You’re Welcome” + Maui Script

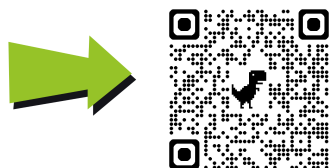
#4 Chief Tui: “Where You Are” + Chief Tui Script

Student Commitment:

- I understand that no rehearsals may be missed for any reason other than sickness.
- I will be responsible in coming to rehearsals prepared (bringing my script, learning lines, practicing songs, and choreography, etc).
- I will respect the adults that make this experience possible and I will respect my fellow castmates.
- I understand that failure to follow the above expectations will result in my participation being reconsidered.

Parent/Guardian Commitment:

- I will provide transportation to pick up my child promptly at the scheduled time on rehearsal days. *(With a group of over 100 students, please understand that early dismissals are disruptive to the rehearsal.)*
- I understand that if my child's dismissal plan is not changed in Pick Up Patrol, they will be unable to stay after school for rehearsal.
- I will provide a costume for my child as instructed by the directors.

- I give permission for my child to be photographed or recorded during rehearsals and the performance of the musical. I understand that these photos or videos may be used for educational purposes, including but not limited to school websites, social media, and printed materials.
- I understand the Student Activity Fee of \$25 due by January 6, 2026. This fee can be paid using payschoolscentral.com.

Parent Involvement

Parents, we need your help! With over 100 students involved in our production, we have a lot of opportunities to contribute to making this a great show! Here are some ways you can help out. Be on the lookout for a signup as we approach the show date.

Costumes: We will need help with the creation of costumes to make our students look great on stage. Sewing, gluing and crafting skills are a plus. We also need help organizing and supervising fittings.

Set and Prop Design: We will need help with set and prop construction. Construction typically takes place on weekends a few weeks before the show. Art skills and power tool experience are a plus!

Dressing Room/Back Stage Supervision: Each student will be assigned to a classroom to prepare for dress rehearsal and the shows. We need parents to assist with make up, hair and costumes during those times. Students will also be backstage during the rehearsal and performances and will need supervision during those times.

Concessions and Raffle: We run a small concession stand and sell 50/50 raffle tickets before the evening show begins. We will need a group of parents to work on the concession stand and sell raffle tickets.
