**Agenda Item Caption:** Consideration and Possible Approval of a Bid Recommendation to Complete Repairs of the Storm Drainage System at Hendrickson High School

**Purpose of Agenda Item:**

**Administrative Recommendation:** Move to approve the proposal of LJ Cross to complete repairs of the storm drainage system at Hendrickson High School, as presented, and to delegate authority to the superintendent or designee to execute the contract.

**Background Information:** This project addresses the need to replace much of the existing storm drainage system at Hendrickson High School. Staff publicly advertised and received a total of three responses to complete replacement of the drainage system that runs across the southwest side of the building. Names of the responding firms, their pricing, and evaluation scores are listed below:

<u>Responding firms</u>	<u>Pricing</u>	<u>Evaluation Score</u>
LJ Cross	\$1,935,496	84
Erbas Construction	\$2,500,000	83
Sullivan	\$2,481,000	76.5

LJ Cross provided the lowest cost and highest rated proposal. Although the district does not have a history of working with this firm, LJ Cross has completed a number of similar projects and comes highly recommended. Therefore, staff recommends the proposal of LJ Cross to complete this project. If approved as recommended, work will begin in early December.

**Fiscal Analysis:** Cost for this project is \$2,185,496 from the 2022 Bond. The proposed cost includes \$250,000 of contingency funding, set aside to account for any unforeseen issues that may arise during the project. Unused funds will be returned to the 2022 Bond.
