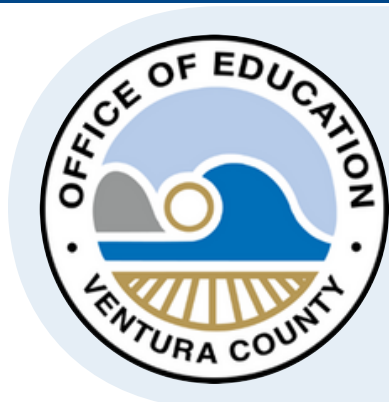


CLASS Resources
