THE GREAT VALU SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Great Valu Scholarship Program is underwritten by the independent owners of Great Valu Supermarkets and UNFI. It is through this scholarship program that Great Valu recognizes the commitment of high school students to their education and communities. The Great Valu Scholarship Program enables deserving high school seniors through the marketing area to receive a \$1,000 scholarship to help defray the cost of their post-secondary education.

The program is managed by Great Valu's Scholarship Committee.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Great Valu Scholarship Program, a student must:

- Be a senior in high school.
- Be planning to enroll (no later than the Fall semester following announcement of awards) in a full-time course of study at an accredited two or four year college, university, or vocational/technical school in the United States.
- Have maintained at least a cumulative 3.0 Grade Point average on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent).
- Be a full-time resident of the Great Valu marketing area, which includes certain retailers in Virginia, Maryland, North Carolina, West Virginia, Delaware, Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

RULES & INFORMATION

Students must complete this application and submit it by deadline, March 2, 2026. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, it is important to answer each question as completely as possible.

All information submitted is confidential and will be reviewed by Great Valu's Scholarship Committee. These scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, age, religion, creed, sex, disability, or national origin.

Awards are for undergraduate study and are not renewable. The monies may be used only for tuition, fees, books or supplies. The scholarship must be used during the academic year for which it is awarded. Associates of Great Valu and/or dependents of Great Valu store owners are ineligible to participate in the program. Great Valu's Scholarship Committee will notify recipients by end of April 2026 by e-mail, and all recipients' names will be posted in participating Great Valu stores. Recipients must verify their enrollment at a post-secondary institution.

Awards will be processed by UNFI, on behalf of Great Valu Supermarkets. Checks will be mailed directly to each recipient's home address in June. Checks are made payable to the student and the school, and must be endorsed by both. Students must inform Great Valu's Scholarship Committee of any changes in address, school enrollment or other pertinent information.

Scholarship recipients have no obligation to Great Valu Supermarkets or their supplier, UNFI Atlantic Region. This program is administered in accordance with IRS regulations.
