What are the strategies we use to help families support their student's learning?

- We believe that school - family communication is a strong component of learning support at home. We engage with families in parent-teacher conferences, phone calls, written communication and in person meetings throughout the year. We also communicate through Friday folders, evening events, monthly PTO meetings, and Site Council meetings.

How do we remove barriers to participation?

- Barriers may include access to resources, work & scheduling conflicts, language differences and lack of awareness. We can remove those barriers by offering family events at different times: some during the day, some evening events, flexibility to meet/call parents when they are available. We can increase family participation by communicating clearly in the preferred home language about the purpose and value of involvement.

Plan de Participación Familiar

¿Quiénes participaron en la elaboración de este plan?

- Nuestra administración, personal, consejo local y familias a través de Youth Truth Data.

¿Qué estrategias utilizamos para ayudar a las familias a apoyar el aprendizaje de sus hijos?

- Creemos que la comunicación entre la escuela y la familia es fundamental para el apoyo al aprendizaje en casa. Nos comunicamos con las familias a lo largo del año mediante reuniones de padres y maestros, llamadas telefónicas, comunicaciones escritas y encuentros presenciales. También nos comunicamos a través de las carpetas de los viernes, eventos vespertinos, reuniones mensuales de la Asociación de Padres y Maestros (PTO) y reuniones del Consejo Escolar.

¿Cómo eliminamos las barreras a la participación?

- Entre las barreras se incluyen el acceso a recursos, los conflictos laborales y de horarios, las diferencias lingüísticas y la falta de información. Podemos eliminar estas barreras ofreciendo eventos familiares en diferentes horarios: algunos durante el día, otros por la noche, y flexibilidad para reunirnos con los padres o llamarlos cuando estén disponibles. Podemos aumentar la participación familiar comunicándonos claramente, en su idioma materno preferido, sobre el propósito y el valor de dicha participación.

En todos los eventos familiares se ofrecen intérpretes de español y de lengua de señas americana (ASL) virtual. Si necesita interpretación en otros idiomas, llame a la escuela.
