When you finish reading, ask them three questions about the story.</p>	<p>Write a paragraph explaining why we have an e-learning day today. Be specific about the conditions that you believe led to the decision.</p>	<p>Find something to read at home that is NOT a book.</p> <p>For example: recipe, directions to a game, newspaper, letter, etc.</p> <hr/>	<p>Create an <u>itinerary</u> for an imaginary trip to the zoo. You will be there from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm. Don't forget to set aside time for lunch. <u>Be sure to note what you'll see and when you'll see it!</u></p>
<p>Weather permitting - build something outside!</p>	<p>Follow a recipe with your family to help make a meal.</p>	<p>Why do we have seasons? Write a paragraph to explain why we have seasons.</p>	<p>Write 10 sentences about a personal interest. For example, write about hockey and why you love the sport.</p>	<p>Create your own 8-problem math quiz based on our current math focus. Be sure to include an answer key!</p>
<p>Write a letter to your family telling them what your favorite part of 3rd grade is so far and why.</p>	<p>Draw a map of Rice with a friend or a family member. Include a compass.</p>	<p>Make a diagram of an ocean environment and explain how a fish survives by interacting with 2 living and 2 nonliving things.</p>	<p>Pretend you are a newscaster. Give a special report to a family member about the book you read today.</p>	<p>Draw 5 pizzas. "Cut" each pizza into different amounts of slices (equal sizes). Shade in the slices that have been eaten. Write fractions next to each pizza to describe how many are left to eat!</p>
