The Board of Education meeting opened with strong Leopard pride as the Lee community filled the room. The Lee Choir began the evening with a patriotic performance focused on gratitude. Principal Willems and two fifth-grade student representatives shared key highlights from the school year, emphasizing what makes Lee a special place to learn and grow, including their schoolwide focus on building trust among students, staff, and families. - The Board moved to approve the first reading of revised Board Policy 5131, Conduct and revised Board Policy 6158, Independent Study
- The Board moved to table the approval of the first reading of revised Board Policy 5141.5 Mental Health
- The Board moved to adopt Resolution 2025-2026-05 on Board Compensation for Missed Meeting, Resolution 2025-2026-06 by the Board of Education of the Los Alamitos Unified School District to authorize closing funds, Resolution 2025-2026-07 authorizing the projects and filing of applications for funding under the state school facility programs, and Resolution 2025-2026-08 for procurement of technology equipment pursuant to public contract code section 20118.2 as allowed by E-rate
- The Board approved transitioning to a new architect for the Los Alamitos High School Performing Arts Center and approved an architectural services agreement with Westgroup Designs to support the upcoming renovation of the facility.
- The Board moved to approve to hold the annual organizational meeting on December 16, 2025
- The Board moved to approve rate increases for substitute positions in classified service and the approval of the Student Supervision Assistant classified salary schedule
