Curriculum Updates:

Math On Level	We will work to identify & classify quadrilaterals. We will look at lines of symmetry within polygons.
Math ACC	We will apply the strategies to division with larger numbers; we will interpret remainders, and solve word problems using division.
ELA (Writing & Grammar)	Students will work on peer revisions in writing. The Georgia Milestones for 4 th grade is changing. In the new ELA portion, students build and apply knowledge about language and organizational structures and elements used to convey and arrange ideas and information in texts. They will look at examples of writing pieces and determine steps to make the writing stronger.
Reading	Students will identify the narrative techniques of a story. The focus will be on how a character's perspective changes in the selection.
Social Studies	Students will describe the causes & events of the War of 1812; students will describe the technological advancements during that time period that impacted the nation.
RethinkEd	Students will understand the role feelings, thoughts, and behaviors play in stressful situations.
