The **Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB)** is a multiple-aptitude battery that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military.



Senior Year

Make **After High School Plans**:

- Apply for College

Apply for **Scholarships**:

- TMCC Promise Scholarship
- Hug Scholarship
- Check Career and College Center

Take the **Civics Exam** (required for graduation)
