Show evidence of enlistment to your counselor.

PREPARE FOR OR COMPLETE COLLEGE COURSEWORK:

1. Achieve remediation-free scores in English and Math on the ACT or SAT
- OR**
2. Earn college credits for one college level Math and/or English course through Ohio's free College Credit Plus program.

Earn a passing grade of 684 or higher on Ohio's Algebra I and English Language Arts II tests. Students who do not pass a test will be offered support and must retake the test at least once.


