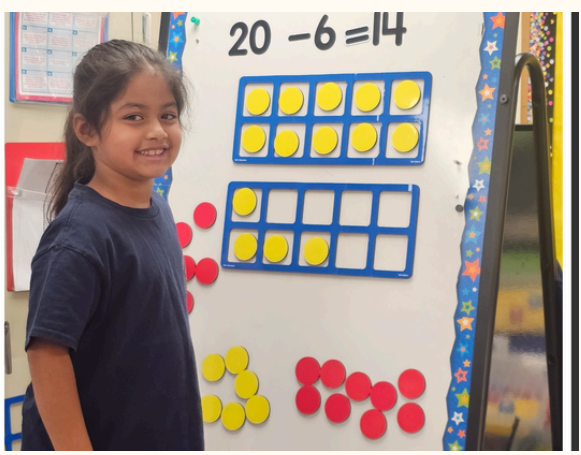

AT WASHINGTON COMMUNITY SCHOOL, STUDENTS ARE SOLVING WORD PROBLEMS USING TEN FRAMES.

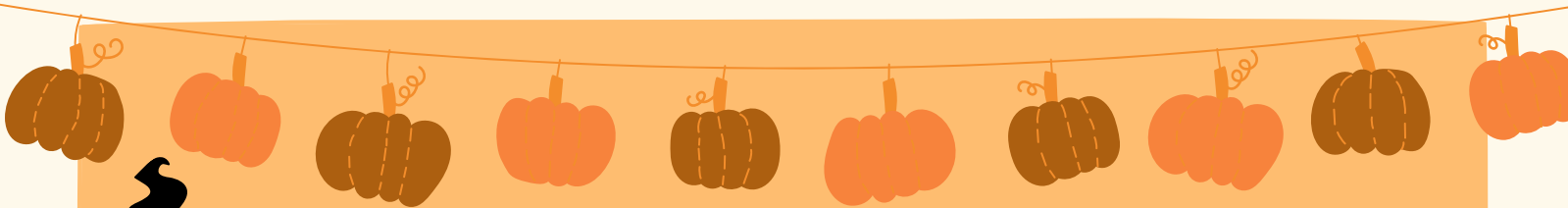


WOODROW WILSON COMMUNITY SCHOOL

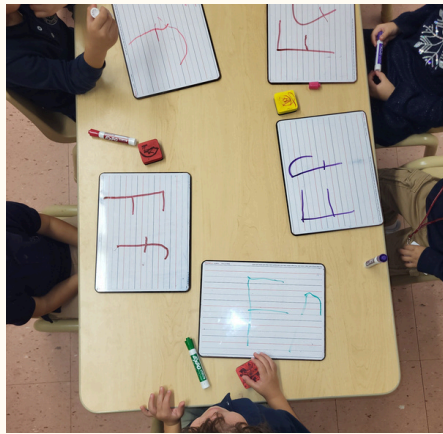
LINCOLN COMMUNITY SCHOOL
