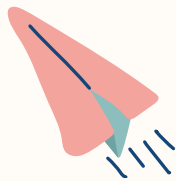

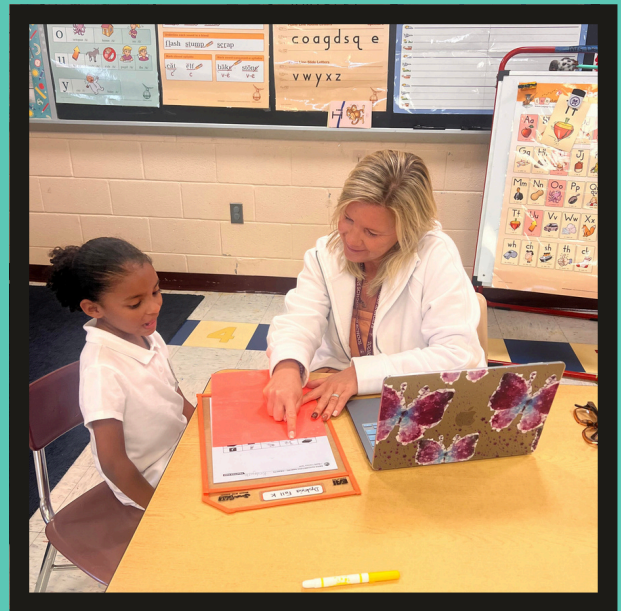

We are working hard, assisting the teachers, and screening students to create our tiers to support our students!



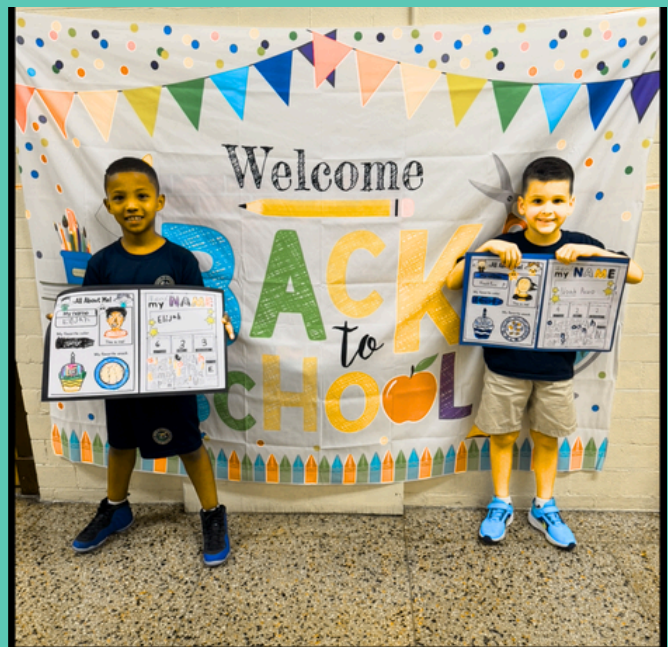
HENRY HARRIS COMMUNITY SCHOOL

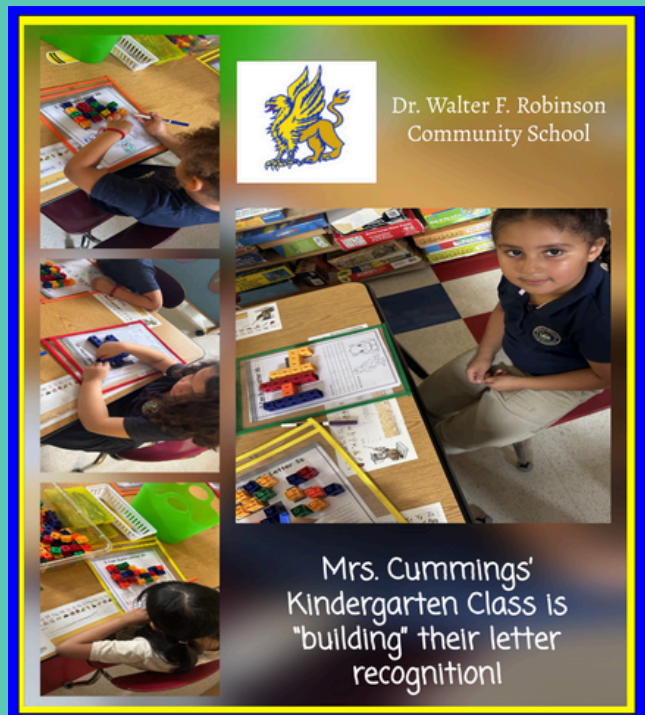

PHILIP G VROOM COMMUNITY SCHOOL

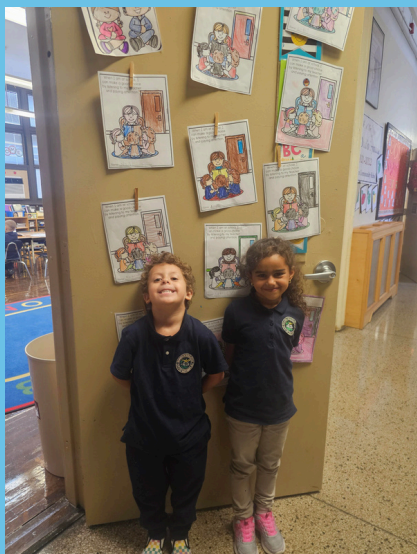

At WCS we discussed good choices to make while we are in school .



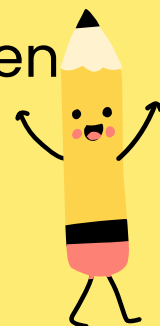
Back to School Night at Lincoln Community School
