

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

The North Middlesex Regional School District School Committee and its staff share the responsibility for ensuring student safety during transportation to and from school with students and their parents/guardians. The authority for enforcing School Committee requirements regarding student conduct on buses rests with the Principal.

To ensure the safety of all students who ride school buses, it may occasionally be necessary to revoke transportation privileges from a student who abuses this privilege. Parents/Guardians of children whose behavior or misconduct on school buses endangers the health, safety, and welfare of other riders will be notified that their children may lose transportation privileges in accordance with regulations approved by the School Committee.
