The data included in a school's report card is retrieved from spring state assessments (Math, Reading, Science, Social Studies), daily student attendance, and high school graduation rates. For the 13th year in a row, Grant Elementary students have exceeded expectations. Grant Elementary scored in the "Exceeds Expectations" level with an overall score of 78.2.

Saturday, December 6, 2025 – 9 am to Noon

Monday, December 8, 2025 – 10 am to 2 pm and 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm

Tuesday, December 9, 2025 – 10 am to 2 pm

Please read the information below and come prepared.

****THERE IS NO PRE-REGISTRATION.** Upon arrival at the toy distribution site you will have to complete a short application form.

****You are allowed to receive toys for your children only or children you have legal guardianship over (please be prepared to show guardianship).** Do not ask if you can get toys for your extended family members, neighbors, friends, etc.

****Please bring your identification card, have your children's birth dates ready, and bring a piece of mail dated November 1st or after, showing your current address.**

****No children allowed.** Do not bring your children with you, they will not be allowed in. Please have other accommodations in place for them.

****If you have received help in the form of toys from another organization (Ex: Angel Tree, Church, etc) for this Christmas Season, you are not eligible for the Toys For Tots Program.**

Please be respectful and patient with phone calls and at the distribution site, everyone is a volunteer.
