Dear Graduates and Parents of the Class of 2020:

With the arrival of spring comes the initial step in planning the graduation ceremony. We suspect that you are eagerly awaiting this memorable event. Each year we receive many questions concerning the distribution of tickets for graduation, and we are taking this opportunity to provide you with important information.

Tickets for graduation will be distributed in the following way:

1. On **Tuesday, May 12, 2020**, during periods **1-8**, graduation tickets and caps/gowns will be distributed during the physical education classes. If a student does not have a physical education class, it is essential that the student report to the east gym during a free hour to pick up the graduation tickets and the cap and gown. By this time, all students should have ordered their cap and gown. **If a student has not placed the cap and gown order, please contact Jostens directly at 847-818-8419.**
2. Each student will receive **four (4) tickets** for the graduation ceremony. All guests, including children, must have a ticket to view the ceremony from the main gymnasium. Due to the size of the Class of 2020, **no extra tickets will be available.** The only way to obtain extra tickets is to ask classmates for tickets they may not be using.
3. If a family will need **special seating** for a guest with a physical disability, graduates can request those tickets on **Tuesday, May 12, 2020**. In order to obtain a special seating ticket, a regular seating ticket must be exchanged. Special seating will be available on the main floor of the gymnasium. A special seating ticket holder can enter the gymnasium and find a seat without climbing stairs. **Please**, only request special seating tickets for those who are truly in need of special arrangements (limit 2).
4. Due to the limited number of tickets available to each graduate, the auditorium and the cafeteria will be open where the graduation ceremony can be viewed via video enhancement. This is an ideal location for **elderly guests** and **children**. All children, however, must be accompanied by an adult. Guests do not need a ticket to view the ceremony in the auditorium or the cafeteria.

For your planning, the commencement begins at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 17, 2020. The graduates are expected to meet in the east gymnasium at 1:30 p.m. The ceremony will conclude shortly after 3:15 p.m. A more definitive letter of year-ending activities will be mailed to you in April.
