Dear Parent/Guardian:

We are excited about the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year at Palatine High School. As we approach the opening of the school year, please make note of the following information:

- **If you have not yet completed the registration process, please do so as soon as possible.** This includes the \$170 registration fee, as well as any other applicable fees.
- Incoming freshmen and students new to Palatine High School must submit their physical, immunization information, birth certificate, and proof of residency before registration can be completed.
- Walk-in registration will be available at Palatine High School from Monday, July 22 through Friday, July 26, 2019 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. (Except for Friday: 7:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.). We will have extended hours on Thursday, July 25 at the Palatine Opportunity Center (Community Resource Center) from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Students may view their course schedule for the 2019-2020 school year beginning July 30 by logging into their Infinite Campus student account; the link is available on the PHS webpage (<https://campus.d211.org/campus/portal/township.jsp>). Your user name will be your student ID number preceded by three zeros; your password will be the first initial of your first name, the first initial of your last name, and then your date of birth using MMDDYY format. For example, student John Smith whose ID number is 123456 and was born on May 18, 2005 would have the following user name and password:

User Name: 000123456

Password: js051805

Please note that you can view your **tentative** schedule in the Infinite Campus student portal. **Official schedules will be viewable in Infinite Campus on August 12.**

POLICY REGARDING SCHEDULE CHANGES

No schedule changes other than schedule errors will be made. Juniors and seniors may drop a fifth/sixth subject without penalty between August 12, 2019 and September 16, 2019, provided the class has been attended regularly. Due to graduation requirements, freshman and sophomore students are required to take five academic subjects. Schedule errors include:

- Missing lunch or any required academic course (not chosen electives)
- Wrong course level
