

BRIERCREST COLLEGE SUNDBO STUDENT HOUSING POLICY

REVISED SEPTEMBER 2025 | APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR OF STUDENT DEVELOPMENT

Sundbo Place is a dormitory designated for mature students who demonstrate readiness for increased independence and responsibility. This policy establishes eligibility criteria and outlines the application process for students seeking residence at this facility.

ELIGIBILITY

Applications for Sundbo housing are open to returning students in good standing (academically and in student life) who are age 21 and older. New and transfer students will normally be placed in alternate dorms for their first year and may apply to Sundbo for their second year. Please note that exceptions to the age limit are rarely made and would generally only be considered in one or more of the following cases:

- The student's 21st birthday falls within 1-2 months of the semester's start if space allows
- On the recommendation of their current RD due to a health issue (mental, medical, dietary) that makes living in other dorms unviable. Supporting documentation from a health practitioner is generally required.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS

- Sundbo tenants do not qualify for senior dorm rebates.
- In keeping with Briercrest's Disciplinary Policy, students in breach of the Students Responsibilities and Expectations may be required to move to a regular dorm as part of their accountability process.

APPLICATION AND APPEALS

Please note the following parameters for applications and appeals:

- Application deadlines for each upcoming semester are March 15th and Nov 15th respectively.
- Students whose applications are denied must reapply every year.
- Any student who proceeds to make private arrangements to rent in community without approval will no longer be classified in good standing with the institution, which is fundamental to many privileges, i.e., student leadership positions, internships, bursaries and scholarships.

- Appeals may be submitted in writing to the Student Development office for appeal committee review. Secondary appeals can be made in person to the Director of Student Development. Third and final appeals can be submitted in writing to the Dean of the College.
- The deadline for submitting an appeal is April 1st or December 1st.
