## Reports:

- **Student Ex-Officio Report:** Ms. Dobmeier reported that as the Roswell Adopt a Family fundraiser wraps up, they are proud to report that over \$2,000 has been raised for two families currently receiving treatment at Roswell Park. Stap Comm will also be sending 6 students and 2 teacher advisors to the New York State Council on Leadership and Student Activities conference, November 23rd through the 25th. This will provide students with the opportunity to collaborate and receive leadership training on a statewide scale. Additionally, they have been planning an Erie County Student Leadership Summit to be held at OPHS, inviting student leaders across our region to share ideas and work together while gaining a better understanding of the school districts around them.
- As a student board member, Ms. Dobmeier has been working with the National Student Board Member Association to start a New York State Association of school board members. With a current executive council, they have been reaching out to all interested student board members in the state and hope to establish an organization that fosters student leadership, parliamentary training, and a positive network for growth. Ms. Dobmeier will continue to update the board on the progress being made for this organization.

- **Adopted revised policies** 7513 – Administration of Medication, 7521 – Student with Life-Threatening Health Conditions and/or Anaphylaxis, 7522 – Concussion Management and new policy 7523 – Opioid Overdose Prevention
- Approved the combining of Girls Wrestling with Frontier, Hamburg and East Aurora school districts.
- Declared several pieces of technology equipment as surplus and approved the sale of a surplus Optoma projector to an employee for \$200.
- Accepted a donation of \$100 from Robyn Young for the 2025 Homecoming, \$1,200 from the American Heart Association for Ellicott Physical Education and Wellness programs and \$1,000 from the Quaker Marching Band Booster Club to pay for percussion instruction.
- Approved the bid awards for transportation items sold via Auctions International, totaling \$44,820.
