 - Respects the power of influence and uses feedback to uplift others
 - Perceives and promotes truth
- Collaborative Leader**
 - Knows when to observe, when to support, and when to initiate
 - Recognizes strength in difference
 - Models honesty, humility, and accountability
 - Advocates for justice and sees through a global lens
 - Believes in the possibilities that come with change, and overcomes obstacles

 - Views challenges as opportunities
 - Persists in making connections and finding solutions through trial and error

Registration and Placement Policies

REGISTRATION: [Entrance Age Policy #5112](#)

- Children must be 5 years old on or before October 1st of the current year to enter Kindergarten
- Children must be 6 years old on or before October 1st of the current year to enter First Grade

SCHOOL PLACEMENT: [Assignment of Elementary Pupils Policy #5120](#)

- All six elementary schools are exceptional
- Make every effort to place child in the closest elementary school but need to maintain class size guidelines.
