

Art/Music—1 unit
Electives—5 1/2 units
Minimum Requirement: 24 units

New York State Regents Diploma: Requires all the above *plus* Regents exams in English, Science, Math, Global Studies, U. S. History & Government.

Advanced Regents Diploma: Requires all of the above *plus* Regents exams in Advanced Math and Science, and Foreign Language (Foreign Language Comprehensive exam)

Unit of Credit: A unit of credit is awarded for a course when the final grade is 65 or higher. A 1/2 unit of credit is given for a half-year course when the final grade is 65 or higher. The final grade is always determined by using 80% class work and 20% exam.

Length of School Day: 8 Instructional Periods plus Lunch
7:30 am—2:21pm
Classes: 41 minutes each period / five times per five day cycle: exceptions—
Regents Science labs & PE: 41 minutes / every other day

SAT/ACT Scores: Holland High School students have consistently ranked above the New York median score on standardized tests. SAT Average scores: Total—1138
Mathematics—579, EBRW—558
ACT composite scores average 24.7.

Advanced Placement: (AP Course) U.S. History, World History, English Literature, Calculus, Studio in Art, Biology, Chemistry

College Courses: Spanish 103/104 - Niagara University , Buffalo State Chemistry, ECC Environmental Science,.

Rank: Students are ranked using all courses taken regardless if passed or failed. If a course is dropped after the school deadline (ten weeks for a full year course, five weeks for half-year courses) a code of DRP/F will be used with a grade of 50.

Rank is determined after 6 semesters and again at the 7th semester in the senior year.

GRADING: Final grades shown in final grade column are unweighted grades. Grades are weighted for cumulative averages on the following scale: AP-1.10, Honors-1.05
