Dear Wyoming Primary Families,

As we move into the winter months, we know illnesses tend to spread more easily, and we want to keep our classrooms healthy and our students feeling their best. To help us do that, we kindly ask that you follow these district health guidelines when deciding if your child is well enough for school:

- **Fever:** Please keep your child home with a temperature of **100.4°F or higher**. They may return once they have been **fever-free for 24 hours without using fever-reducing medication**.
- **Diarrhea:** Children who have had diarrhea should stay home until they have been **diarrhea-free for 24 hours**.
- **Vomiting:** If a child has **vomited two or more times within 24 hours**, they should remain home and may return once they have been **vomit-free for 24 hours**.
- **Contagious Illnesses** (such as strep throat, pink eye, or pertussis): Please follow your clinician's recommendations. If antibiotics are prescribed, children must take them for **at least 24 hours before returning** to school.
- **Head Lice:** If live lice are found, please treat with an effective pediculicide. Students may return **after treatment**, as long as **no live lice are present**.

We truly appreciate your partnership in keeping our school community healthy during this busy winter season. Working together helps ensure our children can learn, play, and enjoy school to the fullest.
