**EXHIBIT 2 – Memorandum of Understanding with Valley
Forge**

Memorandum of Understanding Between Valley Forge Public Service Academy Charter School ("VFPSACS") and Valley Forge Military College ("VFMC")

Effective Date: September 8, 2025

VFPSACS and VFMC share an interest in expanding access to rigorous, college-level learning for high school students. This non-binding Memorandum of Understanding is intended solely for charter/application purposes and to confirm that when VFPSACS opens a high school, VFMC is open to dual enrollment opportunities for eligible VFPSACS students.

This MOU does not create legal obligations, financial commitments, or exclusivity for either party. Operational details, including any tuition/fees, delivery modality, and course mapping, will be addressed later in a simple written dual credit agreement consistent with Pennsylvania law.

Understanding

- 1) Intent to Offer Dual Enrollment: When VFPSACS begins serving high school students, VFMC is willing in principle to make select, credit-bearing VFMC courses available to eligible VFPSACS students for college credit, subject to course availability and standard institutional practices.
- 2) Participation Parameters: Student participation will follow VFMC's usual admissions and placement criteria, seat availability, scheduling, and applicable VFMC policies. High school credit decisions remain with VFPSACS. Any costs, if applicable, will be determined by mutual agreement.
- 3) Next Steps: Upon VFPSACS's authorization and readiness, the parties will designate points of contact and work in good faith to negotiate and execute a dual credit agreement that sets out the specifics for implementation.

Non-Binding Nature; Withdrawal

- 4) This MOU is non-binding and for planning/application purposes only. It may be withdrawn by either party at any time by written notice (including email) to the other.
- 5) Nothing herein creates a partnership, joint venture, agency, exclusivity, or an obligation to enroll any particular student or offer any particular course.
