An integrated program for a student's Jr. and Sr. years, the IB offers a comprehensive curriculum, both broad and deep, which emphasizes rigor and excellence in academic preparation. At Oakmont you may choose the Full Diploma Program or take just one or more courses (the Certificate Pathway.)

For the Full Diploma Pathway students

- take one course from each subject group over their Jr. and Sr. years
- Choose 3 HL courses and 3 SL courses
- Completes the CORE requirements

For the Certificate Pathway Students

- choose courses from any group, schedule permitting
- If you are intending on taking 4 or more AP or IB courses, it is strongly encouraged to consider doing the full IB Diploma. Visit the IB Coordinator to learn more

Academic Planning and Course Selections for Next School Year

9th-11th Grade students received classroom lesson from our counseling team about graduation and college requirements, including planning classes for their 10th, 11th and 12th grade years in their Aeries Academic Plan in November. At this time students should be finalizing their classes in their academic plan for next year school.

Please review the [Academic Plan Instructions](#) and work with your student as they add courses for next year. By December 12th, we expect all students to have submitted their plan to their school counselor (through Aeries), which is the final step of the Aeries Academic Plan process.

Please reference the [Oakmont Course Catalog](#) for information about specific courses, sample plans, and requirements for graduation and minimum college eligibility (UC/CSU a-g). To support the class offerings for next school year, your student received the appropriate grade level document from our [Course Request Sheets](#) during the classroom lesson.

Counselors will be holding individual meetings with all Grade 9-11 students in January and February to review progress toward graduation and finalize course selections for the 2026-2027 school year. This will be your student's opportunity to ask individual questions and make final adjustments to their plan. Please do not contact the counseling staff for appointments about scheduling and academic planning.

Parent Square, Aeries, Homelink Information

ParentSquare/Aeries/Homelink Users can fine-tune their notification settings for posts for each school and district. For General Announcements, you can select Digest, Instant, or choose to turn off notifications altogether (excluding Urgent Alerts and notices.) You can choose to receive email, text, and/or app notifications. We do encourage parents and students to turn on the Instant Text messages so that you can receive timely OHS information directly to your phone. Students will only receive text messages if we have their cell phone on file in Aeries. To learn how to set up your notifications, [please review this document](#).

Parents/Guardians also will receive weekly emails/texts from Aeries that send direct information about student grades and attendance. If texting alerts are set up this will go directly to your phone. Attention All Drivers!

Unauthorized Parking Will Result in Tickets and Towing!

To ensure safety and convenience of everyone we are strictly enforcing parking regulations.

Please be aware that parking in the following designated areas without proper authorization will result in a parking ticket AND your vehicle being towed at your expense. Possible revocation of parking privileges.

- Senior Spots - Painted parking spot and must include OHS parking pass. (Seniors Only)
- Staff Parking - Designated for authorized staff member's only. Clearly marked as STAFF in the parking spot. (Must have New OHS STAFF DECAL)
- Visitor Parking - Reserved for **Visitors only**. (Clearly marked Visitor)
- Handicap Parking - Must have a handicap placard.
- Other open spots - Must have a current OHS Parking Pass.
