Did You Know...

Regular School Attendance...

- Means missing **four** or fewer days each semester for any reason
- Leads to higher academic achievement
- Promotes stronger relationships with classmates and teachers
- Prepares students for success in life

Chronic Absence from School...

- Means missing **eight** or more days each semester for any reason
- Makes it more likely students will struggle in school
- Has a negative impact on the student, the class and the school
- Is related to higher dropout rates
