GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

PLEASE NOTE: The public is welcome to provide comment to the Board. Remarks are limited to three (3) minutes, unless extended or limited by vote of the Board. A maximum of twenty (20) minutes, unless extended by the Board, is allocated for each subject discussed. The Brown Act open meeting regulations under which the Board must operate do not allow Board Members to comment on non-agenda items or information you may bring up that are not on the agenda. Additionally, no action can be taken. However, the Board may give direction to Staff following a comment.

Public Comment (Open and Closed Sessions)

- All Public comment must be made in person.
- The Board President will formally open and close times for public comment for each agenda item. After public comment is closed, the Board will discuss the item and, if appropriate, take action.
- Individuals wishing to address the Board must complete a request card with their name, address and the item number. Cards are located on the table as you enter the room. Cards should be submitted either to the Board President or to the Superintendent.
- Individuals may address topics not on the agenda during the Communications Section (People Wishing to Address the Board) at the beginning of the meeting. However, the Board cannot comment on items not on the agenda.
- The Board, at its discretion, may limit the total time allotted for public comment during each agenda item.
- Speakers must be recognized by the Board President and step to the podium to speak.
- Speakers should introduce themselves and speak into the microphone.
- Speakers are limited to a maximum of 3 minutes, which may be reduced at the discretion of the Board.
- Time allotments may NOT be passed from one person to another.
- An individual may speak only once on each agenda item.
