Mr. Hellmann stated that by a roll call vote Begley, Carlin & Mandio, LLP are our new Solicitors effective immediately.

*Mrs. Worob commented that this local firm is 9 miles away and has 19 people in their organization. She appreciates Mr. Glosser's interest and that he is local but has concerns that he is a one-man firm.*

*Mr. Farrell cast his vote because the firm is local and accessible to the board. Additionally, they may be able to open some avenues to legislation in the state. He feels that it is difficult to get information from PDE and PSBA.*

*Mrs. Mihok reported that Mr. Fitzpatrick explained to her how the district could a tax rebate for the over-taxation of the past two years. He cited a precedent of a case in Tullytown and she thinks this may be able to be done by summer. This is one of the things I have wanted to do all along. We are going to give you back the money that you spent for the school that didn't get built.*
