- DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE A PERSISTENT, PHLEGMY COUGH?
- DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE LICE (WHITE, TRANSLUCENT EGGS THE SIZE OF A PINPOINT ON THE HAIR OR INSECTS ON THE SCALP)?
