### Suggested College Credit Plus

College Credit Plus allows any student in grades 7-12 who qualifies to take college courses while in high school. While APS works closely with our CCAA sister schools, The University of Akron, Kent State University, Mount Union, and Stark State College, students are not limited to these schools. And while the menu of courses is vast as a student's interest and abilities, we recommend that students follow a strategic pathway that will help them move closer to their postsecondary goals. Below is a general suggested 15 & 30-hour pathway that will support students in achieving this goal.

#### 15 Hour Pathway

Intro to Psychology	3	Social Studies or Elective	Required for most majors
Intro to Environmental Science, intro to Biology or Chemistry	3 or 4	Science	Student should meet with school counselor or college advisor to take science required for major
Pre-Calc, Statistics II, or other math as qualified	3 or 4	Math	Student should meet with school counselor or college advisor to take math required for major
Intro to Sociology	3	Elective	Required for most college majors
Art or Humanities	3	Fine Art or Elective	General Ed Requirement
