




What grade are you in?


What school do you go to?


Do you have a personal cell phone?


Do you have a personal smart device other than a cell phone (smart watch, etc..) that you use at school?


What purpose do you use your cell phone most at school?




















Do you enforce your school's student cell phone expectations?


Do you think cell phone management and enforcement should be the same in every classroom?












What school does your child attend?


Does your elementary student have a personal cell phone or smart watch?






Do you have a child in junior high or high school?




Do your junior high and/or high school students have a cell phone or smart watch?






Do you think cell phone use is distracting to your child's learning at school?


Would you support stricter cell phone rules in schools?


Should there be different cell phone rules for elementary and secondary (junior high and high school) students?






