

Hayward USD Safe and Inclusive Schools

Every student has the right to learn in a safe, respectful environment—free from bullying, harassment, discrimination, or violence. This includes protection based on sex, gender identity, gender expression, and sexual orientation. Staff must step in if they see or hear any form of mistreatment, especially toward transgender or non-binary students. If you experience or witness harm, talk to a trusted staff member or make an anonymous report—your voice matters

Curriculum

One way we do this is by proactively teaching positive lessons about diverse identities and history that are integrated into language arts, history, art, physical education and many other content areas.
