**ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY 6.31
PROFESSIONAL RESEARCH ACTIVITIES — CERTIFICATED STAFF**

(1) Research to be conducted in the schools should be appropriate and should not interfere with the major function of the school. Using time of teachers and students in any research activity is an investment by the school system which should increase effectiveness of the educational effort.

(2) Requests involving research projects to be conducted in the Milwaukee Public Schools shall be reviewed for appropriateness by the division of educational research and program assessment. Following this review, the researchers must contact principals of selected schools to solicit participation in their investigations. School participation is always voluntary. The participation of staff members and students within participating schools is also voluntary.
