Dear LaFollette Families and Staff,

We are writing with an update on the lead renovation work happening in your school building. We are committed to providing you with more frequent and detailed information about the progress at LaFollette.

Status of Work

All lead stabilization work and all painting were completed Tuesday, May 20. The building now will undergo extensive cleaning. Afterward, the City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) will inspect the work done at LaFollette.

Students and staff will continue to report to Wisconsin Conservatory of Lifelong Learning until notified. We will continue to provide the support needed as we work through this process for our staff and students at LaFollette.

You are welcome to attend an upcoming town hall meeting for the families of LaFollette School, Brown Street Academy, Westside Academy, and Starms Early Childhood Center. It will be in person on Wednesday, May 28, at 6:00 p.m. at Rufus King International Middle School, 121 E. Hadley St. We will share more details soon.
