* F-1 students can opt into the F-1 Visa Bundle with Cambridge, which includes tuition, the homestay program, and health insurance. If an F-1 student does not require homestay, they will pay General tuition.

**A limited number of 3-year-olds may enroll part-time, either half-day, 5 days/week, or full-day, 3 days/week, for \$15,237 (general) or \$17,444 (corporate). All part-time students join the lunch program.

Cost of Lunch

Students receive a hot lunch every day.

Books

All needed books are included in tuition.

Technology Fees

Fees are used to fund IT support, classroom sets of iPads at the Lower School, Chromebooks for grades 4 and 5, standardized testing Chromebooks at the Upper School, and other support for in-person and remote learning as needed.

Activity Fees

In-school club activities are free to students.

Local Field Trips

Lower School students participate in multiple local field trips each year. Overnight camp trips are included for students in Grades 3 and 4.

Student Support Services

SSS works with students to reach academic, social, and emotional goals through collaboration between students, teachers, and families.

Parent Association Support

\$25 of tuition supports planning and managing volunteer support for ISI community events each year.

College Counseling Services

College Counseling at ISI begins in Grade 9. Activities included in tuition include (but are not limited to): one-on-one and group meetings, resume, application, essay, and interview workshops, PSAT and PSAT practice sessions, scholarship search support, and in-school visits from 60-100 universities annually.
