

# FOUR-YEAR HIGH SCHOOL PLAN- with graduation requirements

In addition to below, students must earn:

- **1.0 credit** of Visual, Performing, and Applied Arts (VPAA). For a list of VPAA classes, please refer to the course catalog on page 15.
- **.5 credit of Physical Education** – can be taken any year
  - .25 Personal Fitness this specific class must be taken or see your counselor for other options
  - .25 Physical Education (PE) elective – we offer many .25 (9-week PE electives) or you can satisfy this requirement by a year of Marching Band or playing a sport. Please complete the PE Waiver if you plan to use a sport to satisfy this requirement.
- **.5 credit Health** – typically taken 9<sup>th</sup> year, but can be 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> year (.5 or one semester)
