




# THE LEADER IN ME AT OUR SCHOOL

- Helps improve learning for all students
- Supports academic growth and family engagement

# HOW DO WE QUALIFY FOR TITLE I FUNDS?

- Based on our % of students receiving free/reduced lunch
- Funding amounts set each year by federal/district guidelines
- Must follow a Schoolwide Title I Plan

- Teachers through training and materials
