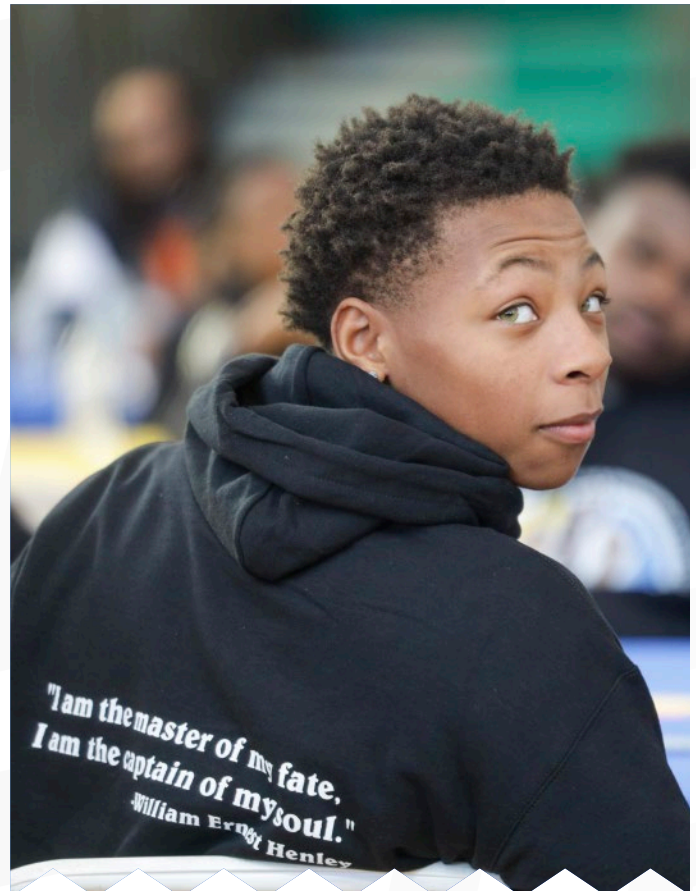

ATTENDANCE MATTERS



WHAT IS ATTENDANCE?

School Attendance - You are counted as present when you attend any part of the school day or are participating in a school-approved activity like a field trip or assembly.

Class Attendance - You are counted as present only when you are physically in class for at least half of the period, have been excused by your teacher to participate in a class assignment, or have been requested by someone on your school support team like a counselor or principal.

Tardiness - You are considered tardy if you are not present the moment the school bell rings for your assigned class. If you are not present when attendance is taken, you may be marked absent, so be sure to have your teacher make the change in your record.

WHY IS ATTENDANCE IMPORTANT?

One of the most important things you can do as a student to achieve success is by going to school every day. The benefits of having social interactions with your peers and learning different subjects in school will help you develop skills that benefit you for the rest of your life. By attending class regularly, you are more likely to keep up with the daily lessons and assignments and take quizzes and tests on time.

WHAT HAPPENS IF STUDENTS ARE ABSENT?

If you are going to be absent, you should have your parent write a letter stating the cause for the absence and the reasons it should be excused. This is important because if you have a prolonged absence or tardiness record, your teachers, and attendance agents are required to check on your wellness. See the table below to learn about our methods.

WHAT OTHER WAYS MIGHT ATTENDANCE IMPACT STUDENTS?

In grades K-8, students who miss 45 or more days over the course of the school year may not be promoted to the next grade level and will need to repeat that grade the following year. In High School, students who miss 23 or more days of a single course in a semester will not pass the course for that semester and will need to retake the course or enroll in a credit recovery course. Additionally, students at examination high schools must earn no more than 9 unexcused absences in a single school year to remain in good standing at their examination high school.

TIPS AND TOOLS FOR SELF-CARE

There is not a one-size fits all answer to self-care. When choosing strategies make sure you utilize practices that are personally relevant and helpful to you and your family. Here are some strategies to consider:

- Recognize and validate emotions
- Stay in the present
- Separate out what you can and cannot control
- Notice and manage your worried thoughts
- Pay attention to joy
- Balance structure and flexibility
- Get active
- Stay connected

TIPS AND TOOLS FOR TALKING TO YOUR CHILD

Talking about mental health – Open ended questions:

- How are you feeling? Can you tell me more about what's on your mind?
- How can I help you feel better? Ya know, sometimes you need to talk to an adult about your feelings - I'm here to listen.
- Have you had feelings like this in the past?
- Do you feel like you want to talk to someone else about your problem?
- I'm worried about your safety. Can you tell me if you have thoughts about harming yourself or others?

TIPS FOR APPROACHING THE CONVERSATION

- Communicate in a straightforward manner
- Speak at a level that is appropriate for your child's age level
- Discuss the topic when you are in a calm environment and your child feels comfortable and safe
- Watch for reactions during the discussion and slow down or back up if your child becomes confused or looks upset
- Listen openly and let your child tell you about their feelings and worries

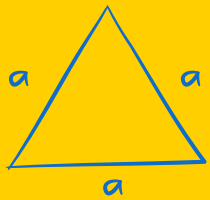
