Dear Parent/Guardian:

I hope the school year is off to a successful start for you and your child. I am writing this letter to let you know that **Charlotte Mecklenburg Virtual School** has been designated as an Additional Targeted Support & Improvement (ATSI) school by the North Carolina State Board of Education. Per ESSA Section 1111(d)(2)(C), schools are identified as ATSI schools in North Carolina because one or more of the following subgroups received a subgroup performance grade score at or below the highest identified CSI-LP school's All Students group during the identification year; and is on the TSI-CU list for the subgroup(s) for the previous year. Subgroup performance scores are provided for the following subgroups: (1) Students with Disabilities, (2) Economically Disadvantaged, (3) Black, (4) White, (5) Hispanic, (6) Asian-Pacific Islander, (7) Multi-racial, and (8) English Learners. This letter is to notify our parents and guardians of **Charlotte Mecklenburg Virtual School's** intentions to improve educational outcomes for underperforming student subgroups and close achievement gaps for all students.

As an ATSI school, **Charlotte Mecklenburg Virtual School** is required to develop an Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) plan that specifically addresses how the school will improve outcomes for underperforming subgroups. The plan will also include strategies that our district or charter will employ to support **Charlotte Mecklenburg Virtual School's** improvement efforts. The ATSI plan will address the following areas (*select applicable areas and remove the remaining areas*):

- Standards-aligned Instruction
- Professional Learning Communities (PLCs)
- Instructional Leadership
- Recruitment & Retention of Effective Teachers
- Support for Grade-to-Grade Transitions
- Implementation of a Tiered Instructional System
- Data-Driven Decision Making
- Student Support Service

We have set the following goals for **Charlotte Mecklenburg Virtual School** this year:

- The percent of students scoring College and Career Ready (CCR) on Math 1 assessments will increase from 19.4% in SY2024-25 to 30.8% in SY2025-26. (Indicators A2.01, 2.04, B1.03. and B3.03)
- The percent of students scoring College and Career Ready (CCR) on reading End of Grade assessments in grades 6-8 will increase from 35% in SY2024-25 to 43% in SY2025-26. (Indicators A2.01, A2.04, B1.03, and B3.03, D1.02)
- The percent of students meeting or exceeding GLP (grade level proficiency) in Math III, English II and Biology will increase from 53.8% in 2024-2025 to 61.8% in 2025-2026 in Biology, from 62.6% in 2024-2025 to 70.6% in 2025-2026 in Math 3, from 70.5% in 2024-2025 to 78.5% in 2025-2026 in English II. (Indicators A2.01, A2.04, A4.10, B1.03, B3.03, and A4.16)

Here are some strategies that we will be implementing to improve student outcomes:

- As a school we have revamped our homeroom to include more targeted time to intervene and enrich students' learning on their academic performance.
- We have analyzed all data in order to create targeted interventions and support for students. Additionally,



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we are re-looping and reteaching standards from our assessments.

Also, parent engagement is at the heart of our school improvement efforts. Here are some ways we can work together:

- Ensure that both you and your child know the academic expectations set for your child this school year. A list of learning objectives in student-friendly language is available from your student's teacher(s).
- Call **Charlotte Mecklenburg Virtual School at 980-343-0742** if you have questions or concerns about your student or to set up an appointment to meet with a school staff member who will be working with your child.
- Make sure that your child is prepared and attends school each day.
- Monitor your child's homework.
- Monitor the progress your child is making and attend meetings with your child's teacher(s).
