Mr. Jamie Fitzpatrick, Oxford Township, commented on CTE building project oversight and 2026-2027 Act 1 resolution.


Mr. Anthony Angelini, CVEA, commented on the accuracy of the public comments given at the last Board of Directors meeting related to CVEA and the upcoming election.
