Credit Recovery 10th – 12th grade

The **Duluth High School Credit Recovery Program** is an opportunity for students to earn course credit in a class they previously failed. **Students who failed a class during the FALL 2025 semester with a final grade between 50% and 69% may be eligible to take credit recovery through one of the options listed below.** Students who failed a course in previous semesters should make an appointment with their counselor to determine the best plan for making up the course.

***FIRST TIME 9th Graders** – The 9th grade teachers, administrator and counselors will communicate the 9th grade credit recovery plan via Parent Square, through 9th grade teachers and through counselors.

Course credit recovery is offered in one of the following formats:

- **Georgia Virtual School (GAVS) Credit Recovery Classes:** Students are placed in a 9th period Online Placeholder with the managing teacher/site coordinator. The teacher/site coordinator will guide parents and students through enrollment with GAVS and monitor progress. These courses are done virtually but students will be placed with teachers temporarily during their lunch/advisement to work on the course. Please see below for more information.
- **Recovery of Credit:** Teachers will embed Semester 1 coursework into Semester 2 to allow students to gain credit for Semester 1. *There is no sign up for this option as it is part of your student's schedule.*
- **Block Math Class at DHS:** Block classes apply to math classes only therefore we are not offering credit recovery in math. Students will be placed in block classes if they fail a math course to help them make up the failed credit. Block classes combine semester 1 and semester 2 coursework. Students that successfully complete the class will earn credit for both semesters. *There is no sign up for this option as it is part of your student's schedule.*

***Classes are offered at no cost to the student. For Georgia Virtual courses, re-enrollments have a required \$25 administration fee if the student has attempted this course on the Georgia Virtual platform and either failed or did not complete the class. The first attempt is free.**



NOTE: The NCAA does not accept Credit Recovery Program course credits for its potential student-athletes.

Georgia Virtual (GAVS) Class Format & Requirements

Georgia Virtual Credit Recovery General Information

- GAVS Credit Recovery classes are offered at no charge to students at GA Public Schools with a site coordinator.
- Students will be placed with teachers temporarily during their lunch/advisement to work on the course.
- The grade will be posted on the official transcript as a credit recovery grade for the course.
- Students must remain in consistent contact with the site coordinator through the completion of the credit recovery course.
- The student/parent/coordinator will all sign an enrollment agreement.
- The student will create a Georgia Virtual Learning Student Account.
- Once the student is enrolled in the course by the site coordinator, the student can immediately begin the coursework. They must login within 10 days of enrollment.
- Students take a pretest at the beginning of each unit. If that score is 70% or higher, the student can click each lesson and view material they need to review and then proceed to the post-test. They must click each lesson and submit any quizzes before the post-test is available.
- If the pretest score is less than 70%, the student must view every content item in the unit. They should carefully review each lesson. When all items have been completed, the posttest will be available to the student. To move out of one unit into the next, the student must score a 70% or higher on the unit posttest.
- *Only unit posttests/final exams/EOC assessments are recorded in the final grade. ELA Courses also have one or two required essays which contribute to the final grade. Students must complete the entire course and the final exam or*

EOC to receive credit for the course. If the course is an EOC course, the student must take the EOC at DHS with the testing staff.

- Students have 24/7 access to complete assignments and move through each unit.
- Support is provided for the student during the student's Advisement period and before school or after school by appointment.
- Re-enrollment of the same course has a required \$25 administration fee.
