



RESURRECTION COLLEGE PREP

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

While at Resurrection, your daughter will be taking College Board standardized tests, such as the PSAT, SAT, and AP exams. We do not offer the ACT at Resurrection, but you can register to take the test elsewhere. Please find the process for requesting accommodations on these tests listed below.

The College Board

Resurrection gives the PSAT and SAT assessments on "School SAT" dates in the fall and spring. All students will take the SAT in the spring of their junior year on this date. Any additional testing dates will have to be registered at collegeboard.org.

- Request accommodations through the SSD coordinator at Resurrection.
- Submit [a consent form](#) to the SSD coordinator at Resurrection. Documents that are on file will be uploaded to the CollegeBoard request system and the appropriate accommodations listed on the school's accommodation plan will be requested. Additional documentation may be requested.
 - Resurrection will only request accommodations upon request from a parent/guardian. Consent forms must be completed and submitted in order for us to proceed with the request process.
 - College Board can take several weeks to make accommodations decisions. Once a student is approved, these accommodations will be active for the remainder of her time in high school. If new accommodations are added, a new submission will also be required with College Board.
- Resurrection staff or administration does not make decisions about College Board accommodation approval; we only submit the documentation on behalf of the student. If a decision returns unfavorable, a reconsideration can be submitted before the next testing date.

The ACT

Resurrection does not offer any ACT testing dates on our campus. You will have to register for an alternative site on the ACT website.

- Create a student profile on the ACT website at www.act.org
- Register for your preferred test date and location.
- Indicate when registering if you would like to request accommodations.
- Once registration is complete, an email from ACT will be sent to the TAA representative at Resurrection.
 - Any documentation that we have on file will be uploaded to the ACT TAA request portal and the accommodations listed on the school's accommodation plan will be requested.
 - Approved accommodations can affect the testing locations available to you.
