**School & Community**

Academia Cotopaxi American International School (AC) is a private, independent, coeducational, and inclusive American international day school serving students from Preschool through Grade 12. We are a member of American International Schools in the Americas (AMISA). The School was founded in 1959 and is located in Ecuador’s capital city, Quito. The student body consists of 558 students in three divisions, Elementary School, Middle School, and High School. 75% of our teachers have Master's Degrees.

We expect the class of 2026 to have 37 graduates. Academia Cotopaxi is proudly international in its student body, enrolling students from 35 countries. 60% of our students are international and 40% are Ecuadorian. Of the international students, 28% are North American.

**Academic Program**

Students in the high school follow a U.S. college preparatory curriculum. Academia Cotopaxi does not offer Advanced Placement (AP) classes. The language of instruction is English and graduates earn a U.S. secondary school diploma. In addition, students can also pursue an Ecuadorian diploma and can choose to pursue a full International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma during their junior and senior years, or enroll in individual IB courses. All IB diploma candidates are required to engage in and complete the assessments associated with Theory of Knowledge and the Extended Essay, as well as complete CAS (Creativity, Activity and Service).

All students are required to complete the requirements of CAS whether they are enrolled in the full diploma or taking a mix of IB and non IB courses. The high school provides extensive extracurricular activities including National Honors Society, Model United Nations, Music, Drama and Student Council. Athletic opportunities include soccer, basketball, volleyball, and swimming.

**Grading Scale**

Academia Cotopaxi has adopted the seven point IB Grading Scale. This scale is used for our GPA calculations. As of 23-24, 0.25 bonus points are awarded for SL classes and 0.5 bonus points are awarded for HL classes in the weighted GPA. Academia Cotopaxi does not rank students.
