ALBUQUERQUE AVIATION ACADEMY ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION INFORMATION

The Albuquerque Aviation Academy is excited to be able to offer students the opportunity to participate in extra-curricular athletic activities. Students and parents are required to complete:

- Albuquerque Aviation Academy Athletic and Activity Code of Conduct
- Parent/Guardian Code of Expectations for Athletics
- Athletic Participation Consent Form
- Sports Pre-Participation Medical Evaluation (Physical)
- Albuquerque Charter School League Coach, Player, Parent & Spectator Code of Conduct (Required by ACSL)
- Any other forms as required by the league participating

Albuquerque Aviation Academy requires that students have an annual athletic physical.

Accident/Health Insurance is the responsibility of the student's parents/guardians.

Students who are members of an interscholastic team at their home district high school are discouraged from participating in the same sport at Albuquerque Aviation Academy. Participation in charter league games will count toward interscholastic game limitations and could jeopardize the home district team's eligibility.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS SUMMARY

1. Students shall be in good standing academically and behaviorally in all of their classes AND
2. Students shall have a 2.0 grade point average AND
Edgenuity course grades will be determined by the Actual Grade until the final two weeks of each semester in which the Relative Grade will be used.

Traditional classes, dual enrollment courses, electives (non-Edgenuity), Smart Lab and Physical Education classes will be determined by traditional standards.

3. No more than ONE (1) Failing Grade (F) AND
4. No discipline issues that resulted in In or Out of School Suspension
5. Receive "Teacher Signature" for all classes AND
6. Have no concerns for Attendance/Tardies

The grade check required to qualify for the beginning of the season must be completed and will be based on the grades from the end of the previous marking or grading period (timing varies depending on the sport or activity). Please see *Grade Check and Player Qualifications* for more information.

Coaches are authorized to require higher academic and social standards, provided these expectations are applied equitably to all participants.

Final determination of a student's eligibility to participate in any sport or activity will be at the discretion of the administration.
